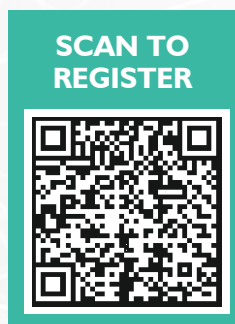

CONFERENCE VENUE RANGARAYA MEDICAL COLLEGE



Established in 1958 through the generous donation of land and buildings by the Pithapuram Raja, Rangaraya Medical College was inaugurated by Neelam Sanjiva Reddy and later taken over by the Government.
